| 1.5 | All participants of the rink are responsible for organizing their own teams to support the league. | | | | | | | | | | | | | | |

| 1.7 | Lack of respect to the facility, or other persons in the facility will result in the shutdown of the facility. | | | | | | | | | | | | | | |
| 1.8 | Garbage is to be kept at a minimum in the facility, and removed by the occupants of the facility. | | | | | | | | | | | | | | |

| 1.10 | No hockey equipment is permitted to be stored in the Logan Lodge luggage room at any time. | | | | | | | | | | | | | | |

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- 1.12 All equipment must be in good working condition, and provided by the user, in order to engage in activities on the ice. All helmets must be CSA approved. No bike helmets permitted.
- 1.13 Lights are to be turned off with the last person exiting the building for the night.
- 1.11 The nearest AED is located outside the entrance to D-Dorm in the Logan Lodge building.
- 1.12 Each person participating in activities relating to the ice rink must sign and submit the waiver form in Appendix A to the Mount Logan Lodge front desk.
- 1.13 All incidents and/or events are to follow normal reporting uses during the commissioning or use of the facility.
- 1.14 All incidents reported while using the facility will be considered non-occupational, per the waiver in Appendix A.
- 1.16 Smoking is not permitted in the building; in designated smoking areas only.
- 1.17 Ice cleaning equipment will be provided by NPA to support ice cleaning during rink use. The users are required to operate the equipment.
- 1.19 NPA Roads and Grounds are responsible to maintain the walkway from Mount Logan core building to the ice rink.
- 1.20 This facility does not have a water source. All sporting beverages, including water are the responsibility of the player.

2. Maintenance of the Ice Rink

Item	Description
2.1	NPA maintenance is responsible for maintenance of the building, service level to maintain the ice to be determined.
2.2	This building is seasonally dependant. NPA Maintenance will make the call for opening dates at the beginning of the season and closure dates at the end of the season.
2.3	NPA maintenance is responsible to safe mode the building upon closure during the summer months.

APPENDIX A: WAIVER

ALL RINK USERS MUST COMPLETE THIS FORM BEFORE STEPPING ONTO THE ICE, AND SUBMIT TO MOUNT LOGAN LODGE FRONT DESK

General Use;

- THE USE OF THIS FACILITY HAS INHERANT RISK, ALL PARTICIPATION OF ACTIVITIES IS AT THE USER'S OWN RISK
- NO RESPONSIBILITY IS ACCEPTED OR UNDERTAKEN FOR THE WELLBEING OF THE USER OR THEIR PROPOERTY. SUNCOR AND BRSS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY BROKEN, LOST, OR STOLEN ARTICLES.
- THIS IS A SELF REGULATED FACILITY – THE EXPECTATIONS ARE THAT EACH USER HOLDS EACH OTHER ACCOUNTABLE
- THIS IS A ZERO TOLERANCE FACILITY FOR VIOLENT, ABUSIVE, OR HOSTILE BEHAVIOUR
- INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR AND/OR LANGUAGE IS NOT PERMITTED
- NO FOOD OR DRINK, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF WATER, IS PERMITTED IN THIS FACILITY
- NO PERSONS ARE PERMITTED ONTO THE ICE WITHOUT PROPER EQUIPMENT, AND ALL EQUIPMENT MUST BE IN GOOD WORKING CONDITION

Use for the purposes of hockey;

- ALL HOCKEY GAMES ARE TO FOLLOW 'SHINNY' RULES
- GLOVES, SKATES, AND HELMETS WITH VISORS ARE TO BE IN PLACE AT ALL TIMES ON THE ICE
- PLAYERS MUST ROTATE TO ALLOW FAIR ICE TIME. SHIFTS SHOULD NOT EXCEED THREE MINUTES PER PLAYER
- 20 PLAYERS AND 2 GOALIES MAX ON THE ICE AT THE SAME TIME
- SLAP SHOTS ARE NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME. PUCK IS TO REMAIN BELOW WAIST HEIGHT. STICK TO REMAIN ON THE ICE
- NO BODY CHECKS, ROUGH PLAYING (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO: HOOKING, SLASHING, FIGHTING) WILL BE TOLERATED
- ALL DEBRIS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE ICE DURING OR AFTER GAMES (BROKEN STICKS OR BLADES)

Use for the purposes of free skating:

- SHARE THE ICE AND USE COMMON CURTEOSY AT ALL TIMES
- SKATERS COMING FROM BEHIND YIELD/GIVE RIGHT OF WAY TO SKATERS IN FRONT
- ALL SKATERS MUST WEAR APPROPRIATE EQUIPMENT. HELMETS MUST BE CSA APPROVED

There are elements of risk on the ice that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. You have the obligation to ensure the safety of yourself and other around you. Help us keep this facility running by using it with respect.
