Batteries for wheel chairs and scooters - Spillable - Battery may have to be removed and packaged as it were a dangerous good if the wheel chair can't be stored upright or it needs to be tipped while loading onto the aircraft. - Captain must be advised	YES	YES

Printer Toner - 500g or Greater	YES	NO
Batteries - Spare/Loose - Including lithium metal or lithium ion cells or batteries for portable electronic devices, must be carried in carry-on baggage only. Articles which have the primary purpose as a power source, e.g. power banks, are considered as spare batteries. These batteries must be individually protected to prevent short circuits.	YES	NO
